We are excited to introduce you to our newly expanded and highly inclusive Retreat Center playground! Over two weeks in August 2025, our old swing sets were removed in order to make way for a ton of new features for our guests and volunteers to enjoy including the Miracle Museum™ Grand Gallery, Interaxion™ Alpha Climber, Inclusive Whirl, Miracle Museum™ Momentum Corridor, and a new and greatly improved swing set with an Inclusive Swing Seat.


